Substance Use Education 12 hour Education Program

Fountain Centers is offering a 12 hour Substance Abuse Education Program for people who are experiencing consequences of drug and alcohol use.

- Topics covered will include:
 - defining abuse and addiction
 - coping skills
 - personal consequences of use
 - peer and family roles
 - lifestyle choices/decision making
- A portion of the program will also provide an opportunity for further assessment to determine if there is a need for additional services.
- The education program will be held as a closed group, running three consecutive weeks. It is mandatory that all sessions are attended in order to successfully complete the program, at which time a certificate of completion will be given and a copy sent to the appropriate referral. There will be no make-up sessions.
- **Cost of the program is \$200, Cash or Check, which is due in full the first session.**

- A parent/guardian must attend with a minor.
