RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

We recognize that treatment is only the beginning of the healing process. We work hard on helping patient's to create continuing care plans that reflect their discharge needs and we are here to provide support even after the program is completed.

- o Recovery Support Group: A trained volunteer facilitates a free group every Tuesday 10 to 11 a.m. and Tuesday 6:30 to 7:30 p.m. and Thursday 5:30-6:30 p.m.
- The Recovery Specialist, a trained Recovery Coach, supports each group by meeting with each facilitator monthly to discuss the motivation of group members, group dynamics and resources available to individuals in recovery
- Sober activities organized by our LIFE Club alumni group and designed to put the fun in recovery
