### **Community Investments**

- Reach Out and Read Program for books that are distributed for free at well-child visits.



# Service Highlights

Mayo Clinic Health System is invested in the New Prague community:

- Added Mayo Clinic Cardiology, Neurology and Urogynecology outreach services.
- Added Podiatry services.
- Broke ground on new operating rooms and a Surgical Services facility remodel.
- Distribute free books at well-child visits through the Reach Out Read Program.
- Established a drive through COVID-19 testing site.
- Provided nearly \$1 million through Mayo Clinic Health System's charity care program, which provides local access to care for all, regardless of ability to pay.
